Sapele

Arguably the most popular African specie due to its good machining characteristics and stability, Sapele has a wide range of joinery applications.

We carry good depth of stock from 25mm through to 100mm.

An increasing volume of this has not only our own checks but independent 3rd party verification of its legality.

Iroko (Odum)

A substitute for Teak with golden colour and durable characteristics.

Our stock in random widths is in 25mm, 50mm, 63mm and 75mm. We also have fixed width 50x230mm and others in fixed widths as available.

Framire (Emeri)

A lower priced general purpose light coloured hardwood.

We have random width stocks in 25mm through to 100mm.

Cedrella

A red plantation grown hardwood which is excellent value, we stock 25mm to 75mm in random specifications.

Sipo (Utile)

Used as a mahogany substitute, we carry stock as available.

FLEGT

Forest Law Enforcement, Governance and Trade or FLEGT is an agreement between the EU and signatory countries that the supply of timber will comply with the EU standards for legal timber supply.

In Africa; Ghana, Cameroon and the Republic of Congo are currently signed up with the possibility of some FLEGT timber during 2011. Negotiations are ongoing with Central African Republic.
